








# MAD Day



#### Tunisia

In <u>Tunisia TEARN (iEARN-Tunisia)</u> 9Avril1938 High School organized a "1000 vote flowers" event in <u>Sfax</u>, as a sensitizing campaign. As Tunisia voted on October 26th to elect its first Democratic Assembly after the Constitution, TEARN thought it was highly important to take part in this national event. So, students under 18 who don't have the right to vote <u>yet</u>, bought 1000 roses and walked around the city and offered them to old people, urging them to vote.
